We have furthermore been instructed to request you, as we hereby do, to provide us with the following information, without which our client is constantly exposed to the risk of unwittingly contravening the said notices:

- (a) A list of all the persons whose names appear on any lists in the custody of the officer referred to in Section 8 of the said Suppression of Communism Act of 1950 or in respect of whom any prohibition under the said Suppression of Communism Act of 1950 or the Riotous Assemblies Act of 1956 (Act No. 17 of 1956), is in force;
- (b) A list of all the organisations contemplated in Government Notice No. R2130 of the 28th December, 1962 and their addresses; and
- (c) A list of all the buildings in Cape Town within which our client is not, in terms of the said banning orders, entitled to be.
