As I went to report to the Police about the iron I was arrested and questioned about Pogo. After explaining that I know nothing about Pogo I was forced to know or mention mentioning out some names and accused them as Pogo members. Mr van Rooyen had me with some names of people staying at St. Columbas whom I knew as residents he said that they are all members of Pogo - I can only remember as far as that as my statement concerned to. As the letter concerns I was telling my brother-in law that people are being arrested and accused of Pogo Organisation

Came in CAPE TOWN 1936. and I now stay at ST. COLUMBUS HOME 52  
SEARLE ST CAPE TOWN, WORKING AT ATHALONE SERVICE STATION, AS A PETROL  
ATTENDANT. ON THE 10-5-1963 I WENT TO REPORT AT NORMAN MTHONISWA  
WHO STAY AT ST. COLUMBUS HOME CAPE TOWN WHO WANTED TO ATTACK ME  
BY AN ~~TOO~~ <sup>TOOK</sup> ~~TOOK~~ OF ABOUT 18INS LONG NOT VERY SHARP BUT SHARP  
BECAUSE I CLAIMED MY MONEY WHICH IS 10s, AND <sup>HE</sup> REFUSED TO  
PAY IT. IT WAS ON 9-5-63 AT ABOUT 9 P.M. WE ARGUED FOR A  
TIME, WHICH AFTER I LEFT AND SET OUTSIDE, WHEN I SAW  
THE SAID MAN HOLDING THIS INSTRUMENT IN THE TOILET,  
AND I RAN AWAY <sup>afterwards</sup> ~~and~~ I THOUGHT <sup>TO</sup> ~~OF~~ TO REPORT THE POLICE.  
THEN SOON I WENT TO CALLEDON <sup>BY</sup> ~~TO~~ POLICE AND I REP.  
10-5-63 TO A CID POLICE, WHO TOLD ME TO COME ON THE  
THE FOLLOWING MORNING AT ABOUT DAWN. THEN I CAME BACK ON  
WHO TOOK ME TO BELLEVILLE POLICE STATION BY CAR  
ON ARRIVING AT BELLOOKE HE GAVE <sup>ME TOOK</sup> ~~TO~~ ANOTHER CID  
WHO ASKED ME ABOUT POKO, WHICH I DID NOT KNOW.  
12-5-1963. OF WHICH HE CAME BACK ON THE 12-5-1963 AT ABOUT  
10PM. I WAS ALREADY SLEEPING HE AWOKED ME UP TO HIS OFFICE  
AND TOLD THAT HE HAD BEEN TO MY PLACE TO SEARCH FOR WEAPONS  
WHICH HE DID NOT FIND AS HE SAID HE ONLY FOUND A LETTER TO MY  
SISTER'S HUSBAND AT TRANSKEI. I ASKED HIM ABOUT MONEY WHICH  
WAS IN MY SUITCASE AND WAS LOCKED. HE DENIED SEEING  
IN THE CASE, AND I ASKED HIM ABOUT MY TWO WEEKS PAY  
OF R10.37C HE DENIED ALL THESE.

THEN AFTER ALL THESE <sup>HE</sup> ~~HE~~ Began Asking ME TO TELL HIM  
ABOUT POKO AND ASSAULTED ME BADLY BY KICKING  
THROWING ME TO THE FLOOR FLLOOR FOR ABOUT THREE HOURS  
FROM 10PM. TELLING ME TO SIGN A WRITTEN LIST  
WHICH I DID NOT KNOW ABOUT IT.

I am a Xasa male born at

I left school after Std II and came to Cape Town to work during 1936.

I speak English.

Since January 1963 I am employed at Afroya Service Station.

During the middle of last year approximately Ngaba Tyali whom I know well and who sleep in the same room as I approach me and asked me to join Fogo. I told him I have no money then. About a week later I gave the 25c to Norman Mtshoswisa and told him to pass it to Ngaba Tyali, and so enlisted to be a member of Fogo.

Subsequently I attended two Fogo meetings at St. Columbus House in my room where I sleep together with the following men:

- ① Ngaba Tyali. ② Samuel Tokozwayo
- ③ Alfred Mhlakela. ④ Roland Puper.

I do not remember the months during which we had these meetings.

At the first meeting I remember the following men to be present:

- ① Myself.
- ② Ngaba Tyali.
- ③ Alfred Mhlakela.
- ④ Samuel Tokozwayo.
- ⑤ Norman Mtshoswisa.
- ⑥ Nundod Tyali.
- ⑦ <sup>1</sup> Nashiya.
- ⑧ Johannes Goduka. We were about 20 men.

There were also some strangers to us.

On this meeting the speakers were Johannes Goduka.

Nashiya

Ngaba Tyali.

They were addressing us on the Aim and objects of Fogo. which

were to get freedom for the bantu by fighting the whites, and killing and driving them out of the country if they do not agree to give us our freedom.

They inspired us to recruit new members.

At the second meeting also in my room I remember the following men present:-

- ① Gogela. Mr. & St. Columbus.  
I know him well. (Riseholme Gogela)
- ② Myself.
- ③ Alfred Mhlakela.
- ④ Norman Mtshoniswa.

Then there were a lot of new faces whom I do not know. We were about 15.

Some of these men paid in money and reported of new members they have recruited.

The Chairman at this meeting was Gogela.

The meeting was opened by Gogela with the Togo salute.

It was a very short meeting. There were no lectures.

I never attended any other meetings because I was working difficult shifts.

I learnt from one of the Togo Members that the Togo meetings were stopped at St. Columbus. by the Caretaker Isaac Mhlauzi.

I was also told by Norman Mtshoniswa that he had resigned and

got his subscription money back from the organizers I think it was Takozwayo and Tyali, because he does not agree with the aims of Pogo.

The leaders of Pogo at St. Columbus were:-

- ① Ngaba Tyali
- ② Ciogela.

They also usually went out to town to organize other members.

Minxod & Tyali an Ngobo also used to go and organize outside the St. Columbus.

Other men I got to know as members of Pogo are:-

- ① Nongauza - St. Columbus. Rac. 1 or 2.
- ② Roland Pape - St. Columbus. Rac. 4.
- ③ Vango Mzunguana - " Rac. 4.
- ④ Maynard Takozwayo (Address unknown)

About 3 to 4 weeks ago approximately in the middle of last month (April) I was walking to work one morning Ngaba Tyali was with me, he told me we are going to start soon. I worked to know what we will start soon. He said start fighting. He will let me know. He also said that the names of certain members will be put down for certain jobs to do but we will be told what and when to do it.

I see my name on a list of names (16) but I do not know who wrote it, or when and

for what purpose.

The following men on this list  
are known to me. They are members  
of Pogo. :-

T. Nishiyo. (St. Columbus)

S. Pupu " "  
Vango Mzumbana. "  
L. Liyo (myself.) "

I recognize a letter signed  
by myself addressed to my  
brother in law.

I did not post this letter because  
I have not got his proper address.

This brother in law is  
James or Johnson Ntako who  
worked for the Dept. of Agriculture.  
at Mbinkulu. That was a long  
time ago.

I was telling my brother in law  
of illness of one of my children  
and had in mind sending the  
child to him.

Where I am referring to Pogo.  
I am telling him "People are being  
arrested here for Pogo, and want  
to know how it is going there.  
I wanted to know whether he  
is in Pogo. If he is in Pogo  
I do not want to send my  
child to him.

die vergadering. Ngaba Tyali was  
oak teenwoordig. Ek kan nie  
almal anhou nie.

EK het ook nie Norman Mthethwa  
& Alfred Mhlakela daar gesien.  
Norman Mthethwa het niks  
gesê nie hy het net gesit.  
EK anhou dat hulle gesit het

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daar moet nuwe hede gevrees word  
Altal moet aanshil; en hulle  
moet hulle 2/6 (25c) betaal; anders  
kan hulle nie vergaderings by-

Soety manne het rapporteer dat

geld inbetaal. Eek weet nie aan  
wie die geld betaal is nie.

Hulle was nie lank besig nie en  
hulle vergadering het sisteem gegaan.  
deur metvaar te groet dan die  
rechterhand op te steek - skouer-hoogte  
en te se "Nzungana".

Gedurende November of Desem-  
ber was daar meer 'n vergadering.  
<sup>in dit area</sup>  
tussen die beddens van Ngaba  
Iyali, Alfred Mhlakela en myse.  
Die aand was toegemaak. Lae  
het hulle my gevra om uit te  
gaan omdat ek nie die 25c.  
paai betaal het nie.  
Ngaba Iyali het my gesê om uit  
te gaan.

Toe ek uitloop het ek gesien dat  
Sagela (hisholme) vigaan. Alfred  
Mhlakela was needs binn en  
oef Norman Mtshoniwa. Laasgenoem-  
de was besig om gereed te maak  
om na die vergadering te gaan.

Daar was nog ander nuwe gesigte  
wat ek nie ken nie.

Eek het na die kombuis ge-  
gaan en daar vertaaf.

In Tyd na die vergadering  
het Norman Mtshoniwa aan my ge-

si dat die Pogo manne si dat  
hulle gaan veg teen die wit  
mense, en hulle doodmaak en  
dat hy nie hulle gesê het. hy  
hou nie saam nie en hy gaan  
bedank by hulle. Hy het my gesê  
dat hy vir <sup>hulle</sup> gesê het om sy geld  
geld terug te gee en dat hulle  
hou sy <sup>25c</sup> teruggegee het.  
Hy het my ook gesê ~~dat~~ nie  
hou sy geld teruggegee het.  
maar ek het nou begreep  
wie dit is.

Ek het hoor toe nog gesê  
of my besig is om my te  
verveeg om aan die shirt, maar  
hy het gesê, nee hy word  
my maar net wat. hulle sê  
hulle wil daan.

en Daniel Takozwayo besig is

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am te stay. Ek het verneem  
dat die spesuders vir Samuel  
Lokozwayo anderwa het. jam.  
Togo en dat hy vir Norman  
Mlshouise blangeet dat hy in-  
ligting aan die Polisi gegee het.  
Hy was met Norman kakkii.

Norman het toe na hulle  
gegaan. Die genoemde manne  
het toe besluit dat hy moet trek

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Daar is 'n gewaarslike wapen in een van die gernakhuisse, en almal het geshuil dat ons aan die Politie moet sê dat is Norman se wapen sodat hy opgeshuil kan word.

Ek het beduid am dalk op my te meer en ek het in kleursting spesender wat ek ken by Koopstad polisiestasie gaan sê. Die spesender en nog ander het gekom en ek het hulle die gernakhuis gevys. Hulle het iets in 'n stuk koubers daar onder plankie uitgehaal ek het late gesien ais 'n stuk yster met skerp punt.

Die politie het met Norman gespraaft maar hou nie saamgeleem nie.

Norman het vorigend <sup>na</sup> ~~ontstaan~~ die Politie gegaan. Ek het ook gegaan en han daar gekry.
