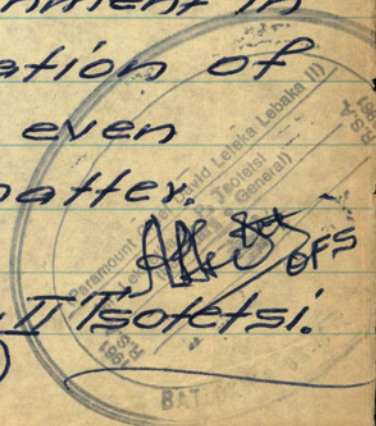

No homeland leader or government in South Africa ~~represents~~ represents this nation of the Kingdom Of Mokgalong even Pretoria well know this matter.

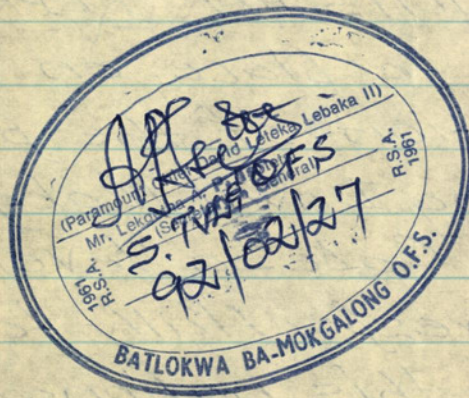

RE: MOKGALONG MANIFESTATION TO CODESA:

So, an agreement of this recognition nature be urgently entered into between the Kingdom Of Mkgalong and CODESA which will obviously create mutual co-operation and sympathetic understanding in specifically providing us ^{with} the establishment of good relations.

Furthermore, this will help CODESA to be in a position of having a good background information of the respective Mkgalong people of ancestral King Tsotetsi in this country.

All this, can only be covered by our own representations between ourselves and CODESA directly. We understand very well the form that our negotiations will actually be expected to take with you into a majoritarian country.

The people of Mkgalong have already proved themselves politically competent on various occasions through their meetings, consultations and talks held with and representations communicated to Pretoria, Olundi, Mafikeng, Umtata, Pietersburg (C-G), Phutha-tjhaba (C-G), UN, OAU (Lusaka), England including Trede, Springs and Bloemfontein.

Further, CODESA should well understand that there has never been any official agreement entered into between this people/nation of H.M King Tsotetsi and any homeland government through the recognised channels for whatever kind of representation. This is well known in Tuynhuys and Union Buildings.

Kind here attached, photostated copies of your recognition replies to the people of His Royal Highness King David Lebeka II of King Mkgalo/Leleka Tumis; Tsotetsi; Monarch Tsotetsi must be included for CODESA to be broadly representative.

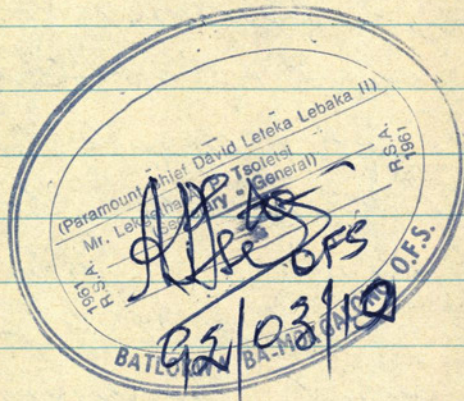

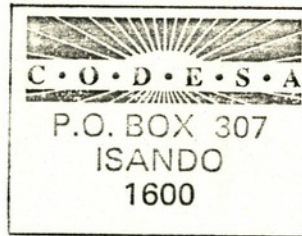
