Dear Sir / Madams,

Our board favours the following:-

- 1) Peace must first be achieved by increasing the police force. All people must have a way to move permanently to another area & they must have a job to go to. Otherwise they must return to their original home.
- 2) Once peace is achieved every effort must be made to help the blacks. The Apartheids have had their chance since 1948 until now. With international loans, black homes & schools can be improved.
