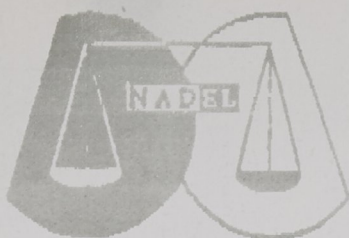



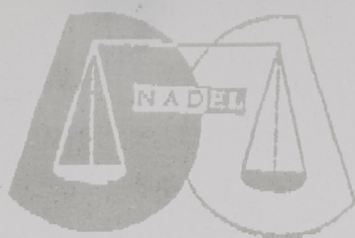

Members are requested to ensure the urgent collection of all Membership Renewal forms and subscriptions from all recalcitrant members appearing on the annexed list.


