CODESA DELEGATION TO OBSERVE THE BRITISH GENERAL ELECTIONS

We were delighted to hear from Mr Mac Maharaj of the CODESA Secretariat that you and all copy addressees of this letter have agreed to be members of the CODESA delegation to observe the British General Election which will be held on 9 April.

We have reserved seats on flight BA 056 departing Johannesburg at 2015 on Sunday 5 April, and for the return journey, on BA 059 departing London Heathrow at 2200 on Friday 10 April, arriving Johannesburg at 0935 on Saturday 11 April.
