

I understand that the Codesa Working Group 2 is concerned, inter alia, with consideration of new national symbols for this country. In this regard I wish to inform you of the existence of our Association. We would be very happy to share our expertise with you, particularly in respect of the design of a new national flag.

The Southern African Vexillological Association (SAVA) has as its objectives:

 to record and preserve any and all information relating to flags in general and the flags of southern Africa in particular;

ii) to undertake research and study programmes, organise conferences and symposia, and to exchange information on flags and related matters with similiar Associations and Institutions elsewhere in the world; and

iii) to act as an information source for the general public and any interested bodies on all matters pertaining to flags.
