Dear Dr De Beer,

I have been directed to convey to you the following motion adopted unanimously by the Joint Regional Congress of Chambers of Commerce and Industry in the Northern Cape and Orange Free State, held at Bethlehem on 25 April:

"This Congress, being fully supportive of the broad political processes designed to create a new constitutional dispensation in South Africa, is deeply concerned at:

- i] The poor performance of the South African economy as a whole in recent years and the current prolonged recession.
- ii] The lack of regional growth and development in the Orange Free State and the Northern Cape.

And therefore urges the Government and other political leaders in South Africa to:

- a] Focus more attention on the formulation of confidence-building development strategies to promote economic growth and job creation nationally and regionally to meet South Africa's economic and social needs.
- b] Facilitate even closer cooperation with the private sector to formulate and implement mutually integrated regional economic development strategies.
- c] Create a further working group within CODESA to address economic and financial issues which are fundamental to successful political change in South Africa, and

d] Devise an appropriate mechanism to ensure participation by the Government in the proposed national economic forum of business, labour and the governing authority,
