

GENERAL CONSTITUTION PRINCIPLES TO BE ENSHRINED
IN A NEW CONSTITUTION.

1. A federal form of government with appropriate form of autonomy for the central regional and local government.
2. A clear separation of power into Legislative Exetutive and Judiciary with the necessary checks and balances.
3. A Bill of universal human rights, specifically including the acknowledgement of the diversity of language, culture and religion.
4. A multiparty democracy with regular elections.
5. Recognition of the Constitution as the Supreme Law.
6. Equality of all citizens before the law.
