### 1. OPENING OF THE MEETING AND WELCOME

P Maduna opened the meeting at 10H25. He apologised for the late start and welcomed back the members who had gone to witness the UK elections. He also apologised for having to postpone the meeting of 21 April

### 2. APOLOGIES

There were no apologies as all delegations were present.

### 3. RATIFICATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE NINTH MEETING OF WORKING GROUP 3

3.1 The following amendments were suggested:

7.11 emerging consensus instead of general consensus

3.2 VB Ndlovu proposed, LL Mtshizana seconded, and the WG duly accepted the minutes.

### 4. TABLING OF THE MINUTES OF WG3SC

4.1 P Maduna drew the attention of WG3 to the suggested change by WG3SC to 4.2.2  
4.2.2 "On reaching agreements, proposals should be drawn up by the rapporteurs and submitted to the WG3SC for consideration."

4.2 The meeting of WG3SC was held at 16H00 not 17H00.



**5. TABLING OF SUBMISSIONS**

Submissions from The Women's Lobby and the Pinetown Child and Family Welfare Society were received by WG 3.

**6. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA**

The agenda of WG 3 was accepted as is.

**7. TABLING OF THE REPORT OF THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE**

7.1 K Andrew presented the report of WG 3 Technical Committee.

7.2 Points of clarification were raised by delegates.

7.3 T Mbeki announced that H Cheadle was not present due to a tragic accident he was involved in over the Easter holiday in which his daughter lost her life. T Mbeki proposed, D de Villiers seconded and the WG agreed that a message of condolence be sent to the family.

7.4 L Landers proposed that the document of WG 3 Technical Committee be released to the media by the chair to preempt leakage. It should be stated that the document is a working document which the parties are still to discuss. A Chaskalson suggested that the outstanding issues be specified.

7.5 P Gordhan will raise the issue of the press release with the DMC and together with P Maduna will release the document as suggested in 7.4 above.

7.6 The Technical Committee was congratulated for its work.

7.7 It was suggested by P Gordhan and supported by D de Villiers that reservations and comments should be raised for noting and further discussion by the Technical Committee.

7.8 It was agreed by the WG that the present Technical Committee be maintained and WG3SC was charged with deciding on the convenor.

7.9 It was agreed that the delegates take the existing report with comments discussed in the meeting back to their principals for discussion. The Technical Committee should attempt to meet to elaborate on the document based on the comments by the WG. If the Technical Committee makes progress, they should on Monday, circulate a revised document. If questions of principle are raised by delegates, these should be faxed to CODESA for the attention of the Technical Committee before the end of the week. The matters of the TBVC states and the relationship between the TEC and present government structures should be discussed by the delegations in preparation for the next meeting.

**10. OTHER URGENT BUSINESS****10.1 SABC**

L Landers proposed and R Carlisle supported that the Chairman make contact with SABC to raise with them that their projection of the Technical Committee Report as an agreement and not a working document was incorrect and needed to be rectified. The WG agreed that P Maduna take the matter up with the DMC. P Maduna also informed the meeting that the interview with him that was broadcast on SABC did not actually take place. Parts of the press conference has been extracted to produce this interview.

**10.2 MARKETING CODESA**

- 10.2.1 L Mtshizana raised the issue of CODESA participants undermining the CODESA process by holding discussions outside CODESA on the future of CODESA and then projecting CODESA publicly in a bad light. He wanted it to be noted that the Transkei delegation objects to this.
- 10.2.2 The IFP, Ciskei, and South African Government delegations pointed out their objections to L Mtshizana's statement. The South African Government stated that if L Mtshizana wished to pursue the matter, the issue of bilateral and multilateral discussion should be placed on the next WG meeting agenda.
- 10.2.3 No agreement was reached on this matter.

**10.3 MEETING BETWEEN WG2SC AND WG3SC**

- 10.3.1 P Maduna reported that WG2SC and WG3SC had met.
- 10.3.2 The meeting had explored the idea of joint meetings as mandated by the Working Groups.
- 10.3.3 It was agreed that the chairs of the Working Groups would consult on a regular basis and further meetings would be dictated by need.

The meeting closed at 15H30.
