

INYANDZA NATIONAL MOVEMENT

PROPOSAL FOR CENTRAL, REGIONAL AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT

- There will be a three-tier structure of government: central, regional and local.
- Each tier of government will be based on democratic representation, subject to the bill of rights and the constitution.
- 3. Each tier will have legislative, executive and fiscal authority in respect of powers which will be defined and enshrined in the constitution.
- 4. The government may delegate any of its powers to a regional government and a regional government may delegate any of its powers to a local authority.
- The different levels of government may have concurrent powers.

- The regions will be defined on the basis of the 9 development regions, with appropriate alterations.
- 7. The constitution will recognise metropolitan governments for large urban areas.
- 8. The allocation of funds to the regions should be formula-based and not discretionary, so as to prefer underdeveloped over developed regions.
- 9. The allocation of funds by a region to its local authorities should be formula-based and not discretionary, so as to prefer underdeveloped over developed local authorities.
