THE VERWOEFDIAN PLOY TO IMPOSE TRIBALISM AND ETHNICITY WAS BOUND TO FAIL AND IT HAS FAILED. THIS NAKED FORM OF RACISM HAS DELIVERED UNTOLD SUFFERINGS UPON THE OPPRESSED PEOPLE OF SOUTH AFRICA. CHARACTERISED BY THE HIGH RATE OF UNEMPLOYMENT AND THE HIGH INFANT MORTALITY RATE.

THE CREATION OF HOMELANDS WAS INDEED THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PILLARS OF GRAND APARTHEID. CODESA CANNOT BE TAKEN SERIOUSLY BY THE GREAT MAJORITY OF OUR PEOPLE IF IT SEENS TO CREATE A NEW DEMOCRATIC ORDER AND DISMANTLE APARTHEID WHILE LEAVING THESE PILLARS OF APARTHEID IN PLACE.

SINCE THEIR ESTABLISHMENT THE TBVC STATES HAVE FAILED TO WIN THE RESPECT AND RECOGNITION OF THEIR INHABITANTS, THE MAJORITY OF SOUTH AFRICANS AND THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY. THE POSITION OF THE INM IS THAT THE RE-INCORPORATION OF THE TBVC STATES INTO SOUTH AFRICA IS AN INEXTRICABLE PART OF 4 GENUINE PROCESS OF DISMANTLING APARTHEID AND ESTABLISHING A DEMOCRATIC ORDER WHICH WE BELIEVE THE CONVENTION FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOUTH AFRICA IS ALL ABOUT.
