#### Ratification of Agenda 2.

- The agenda was ratified with the following changes: 2.1
  - Item 5.6 which reads as follows was added: "The role of standing committees in the 2.1.1 formulation of legislation."
  - Item 6.2 was amended to read: "Item 4.4 of the Minutes of the Meeting of 2 March 2.1.2 1992: Further discussion of the common principle regarding the balance between central, regional and local government".

#### 3. Ratification of Minutes

- 3.1 The minutes of the meeting of 9.3.92 were ratified with the following changes:
  - 3.1.1 D Worrall was added to the list of apologies for 31.3.92 and A Leon was listed as his alternate.
  - 3.1.2 Item 3.1.3 was amended to read: "Mr Mabuza pointed out that he and Mr Lephoko had attended the meeting of 23.3.92."

#### 4. Discussion on Assignment 2: Constitution Making Body and Process

- 4.1 Delegates continued questioning the ANC on their submission of 31.3.92.
- 4.2 The following parties made submissions on the issue:
  - 4.2.1 Bophuthatswana Government
  - 4.2.2 Inkatha Freedom Party
  - 4.2.3 The meeting ended before questions to the Inkatha Freedom Party could be completed. It was agreed that questions would be continued at the next meeting.
- 4.3 The chair posed the following questions as a useful means to take the discussion forward:
  - 4.3.1 "Based on the following assumptions regarding a Constitution Making Body:
    - 4.3.1.1 It is not a "sovereign" body, but a body established through legislation by the South African parliament;
    - 4.3.1.2 It is bound by the parameters of principles agreed to in Codesa including inter alia regionalism entrenched in the constitution and a Bill of Rights;
    - 4.3.1.3 It is bound to take decisions in terms of procedures agreed to in Codesa;
    - 4.3.1.4 Its decisions are subject to scrutiny by a panel of judges or neutral, independent persons to determine that these have been in accordance with the above;
    - 4.3.1.5 It would not necessarily be involved in legislative functions or procedures;
    - 4.3.1.6 The constitution it drafted would be subject to endorsement by popular referendum.

In these circumstances, in order to raise the level of legitimacy of a Constitution Making Body, would it be appropriate for the electoral principle to be applied in practice on the basis of regions? In view of the fact that regionality is a constitutional principle already agreed on, could a case be made for this regionality to be reflected in the composition of the constitution making body?"

## 5. Next Meeting

- 5.1 The next meeting will take place on 21.4.92 from 10h00 to 16h00 at the World Trade Centre.
- 5.2 It was agreed that Working Group 2 would also meet on 27.4.92 from 10h00 to 16h00 and on 28.4.92 from 9h00 to 15h00.
