1. Chairperson's Opening Remarks

2. Adoption of agenda

The agenda was adopted with the following amendment: Items 5 and 6 were deleted from the agenda as there were no further developments to discuss.

3. Adoption of minutes

The minutes of the meeting of the Steering Committee of the 30 March 1992 were adopted without amendment.

4. Meeting with the DMC\Secretariat

- It was agreed that Z Skweyiya and Y Moolla would attend the meeting of the Steering 4.1. Committees with the DMC\Secretariat scheduled for 15h00 on Tuesday 28 April 1992, accompanied by LPHM Mtshali and R Burrows.
- The proposed working procedure for task groups, as outlined in 10 points by the Task Group 4.2. convenors of Sub-group 2, on 9 March 1992, would be referred to the meeting.

Attendance of the plenary sessions of other Working Groups 5.

The following procedure was proposed with regard to the attendance of members of Working Group

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5 Task Groups at the corresponding Working Group plenary sessions:

- 5.1. Both the administrative staff and the members of Working Groups 1 4 should expect the attendance of the Task Group Members of Working Group 5 at their plenary sessions.
- 5.2. Members of Working Group 5 Task Groups would attend all plenary sessions that did not overlap with the plenary of WG 5 itself.
- 5.3. Clarification would be sought from Working Group 5 plenary as to whether during sessions where there was an overlap between its own plenary session and that of another Working Group a representative from the relevant Task Group would be mandated by that Task Group to observe the corresponding plenary or not.

6. Reportback to CODESA 2

It was agreed that Y Moolla and Z Skweyiya would draft a report of Working Group 5 for CODESA 2 to be presented to the plenary session on Monday 4 May for discussion. This report will be forwarded to members of the Steering Committee for evaluation and inputs. Upon receipt of their responses a final report will be drawn up to present to the Working Group for comments.
